The regular meeting of the Basalt Town Council was called to order at 6:00 PM by Mayor Jacque Whitsitt.

Council Comments and Town Manager's Report:

Town Manager Mike Scanlon updated Council on WeCycle as per the flyer distributed at the meeting.

Bernie Grauer congratulated Jacque Whitsitt and welcomed the new council members Auden Schendler, Katire Schwoerer and Jennifer Riffle to Council. Bernie thanked Rick Stevens, Herschel Ross (and Rob Leavitt) for their service these past 4 years. Bernie Grauer said he saw a pretty unified direction from the voters favoring 3 out of the 4 who favor low growth, lower density and slower growth; a somewhat new direction on the council. Bernie indicated he was from the camp of more growth and thought it would be beneficial to meet and see what direction the new Council would like to take, and thought the Council should be open to looking at a new direction. Bernie said he still advocated a significant hotel and possible office on that space following the Downtown Area Advisory Committee's (DAAC) report. Bernie said he was very open to the new ideas and working with the new Council.

Bernie Grauer asked about the Request for Statement of Qualifications for Architectural Design Services for the Basalt River Park and Other Projects on the Town's website.

Mark Kittle echoed Bernie's comment congratulating the new council members and thanking the outgoing members.

Jacque Whitsitt said there had been record voter turnout – 54-55% of registered voters, and congratulated the voters of the town.
