3. The International City/County Management Association (ICMA) and its membership have a program that will recognize those local governments that have established professional management positions.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BASALT TOWN COUNCIL OF BASALT,

2. That upon notification of being ICMA recognized that the Town Manager and Town Clerk will notify all of the local media outlets.


