RECITALS

WHEREAS, an organizational goal of the Basalt Police Department is to provide the highest level of public safety by continually assessing, analyzing and improving the services we provide while enforcing laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the systematic use of partnerships and problem-solving techniques to proactively address conditions that give rise to health, safety and public peace issues through collaborative working relationships is a guiding principle of the police department and the Town; and

WHEREAS, establishments that possess liquor licenses within the Town have expressed a desire to work with the police department to create a Responsible Service and Safety Program for their businesses and the Town; and

WHEREAS, the police department wishes to create such programs to enhance the health, safety and public peace of the residents and visitors to Basalt while striving to increase vitality in the restaurant and service industries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Basalt, Colorado that:

The Town Council, in an effort to increase public safety and enhance working relationships within the Town, directs the Basalt Police Department to work cooperatively with businesses possessing liquor licenses to create a Responsible Service and Safety Program within the Town of Basalt


