

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BASALT, COLORADO, DIRECTING
STAFF TO CONTINUE THE COMMUNITY SURVEY WORK WITH THE OUR TOWN
PLANNING PROCESS**

RECITALS

Whereas, the Town of Basalt through various actions of the Town Council and Planning and Zoning Commission have identified alternative approaches for the development and redevelopment of the downtown corridor.

Whereas, the Town acknowledged in Resolution No. 68, Series of 2013 that it is important to involve the community in a downtown planning effort given the level of investment being made in the downtown area and approved the preliminary planning framework for Downtown Development through approval of Resolution No. 68, Series of 2013.

Whereas Resolution No. 05, Series of 2014, adopted and formalized the final planning framework.

Whereas the Town Staff and its consultants received maps and held chat sessions pursuant to the final planning framework through May 28, 2014. Over 600 people participated in the discussion through numerous information meetings, chat sessions, planning meeting with school children and drop in discussions at Clasen's Corner with more than 300 drawings submitted, translating into more than 3,000 ideas. This portion of the effort culminated in a Summary Findings Meeting on May 29, 2014, and a report entitled, "Our Town Planning: A Report on Informal Networks, Basalt 2014".

Whereas, the community members have been asked to vote on one of three site plans and asked to provide their preferences on different development scenarios for the Our Town Area through June 23rd.

Whereas, the responses to the vote indicate that surveying the community provides valuable input for determining the ultimate pattern and level of development of public spaces and private spaces in the Our Town area, and that additional valuable input and consensus can be obtained by asking our community additional questions.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF BASALT, COLORADO:**

Section 1. The Town Council directs Staff to continue the community survey work with the Our Town Planning process.


Section 2. The Town Council directs Staff to tally the data from the surveys as part of the groundwork for making decisions in the Our Town Planning Process.


