RECITALS


1. Pitkin County has engage in a very public and transparent process to determine the future reconstruction of the Aspen/Pitkin County Airport.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Basalt Town Council of Basalt, Colorado, as follows:


