RECITALS

Whereas, Water efficiency and conservation are important for the Town of Basalt.

Whereas, the Town entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City of Aspen, City of Glenwood Springs, the Town of Carbondale, Snowmass Water and Sanitation District and Community Office for Resource Efficiency (CORE) in 2013 to participate in development of a Regional Water Efficiency Plan.


Whereas, the Town entered into an agreement with Element Water Consulting and Water DM Demand Management to develop the Municipal Water Efficiency Plan for the Town of Basalt.


Whereas, the Municipal Water Efficiency Plan for the Town of Basalt has been completed in Draft form, was posted on the Town of Basalt website and notice was placed in the Aspen Daily News on Feb. 27, 2015 requesting public comment.

Whereas, the Colorado Water Conservation Board (CWCB) has granted conditional approval contingent upon the Town's approval of the Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Basalt, Colorado, as follows:

1. The Municipal Water Efficiency Plan was available for public inspection and comment through the Basalt Town Hall, 101 Midland Avenue, Basalt, Colorado during normal business hours, and is available on the Town's website at www.basalt.net/waterplan.
2. The Municipal Water Efficiency Plan for the Town of Basalt was sent to The Colorado Water Conservation Board (CWCB) for comment.
3. There were no public comments.
4. The Municipal Water Efficiency Plan was adopted as presented this 26th day of May, 2015, by a vote of 7-0.
