

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BASALT, COLORADO, GRANTING  
APPROVAL FOR THE BASALT SUMMER ARTS BEAT CONCERT SERIES IN LIONS  
PARK IN DOWNTOWN BASALT**

**Town of Basalt, Colorado  
Resolution No. 28

**RECITALS**

1. Marc Breslin on behalf of the Town of Basalt ("Applicant"), requested approval from the Basalt Town Council for the use of Lions Park for the purpose of a weekly, Wednesday Night Concert called the Basalt Summer Arts Beat Concert Series.
2. The concerts will occur each Wednesday evening beginning on July 8, 2015 through August 12, 2015 from 5:30 p.m. until 8:30 p.m.
3. The use of public spaces is allowed on a case by case basis in a recurring manner pursuant to approval of a resolution by the Town Council.
4. The Basalt Town Council considered the application at a public meeting on June 9, 2015.
5. The Basalt Town Council finds that the Applicant's request is consistent with the applicable provisions of the Town Code, provided Applicant adheres to the conditions identified in this Resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Basalt Town Council of Basalt, Colorado, as follows:

The Basalt Town Council incorporates the above recitals and all exhibits as references and as findings and determinations, and conclusively makes all of the findings of fact, determinations and conclusions contained herein.

### FINDINGS

1. Based on the evidence, testimony, exhibits, and comments from the public, Applicant, and Town staff, the Basalt Town Council Finds and determines that the proposed use does not violate any standard of the Land Use Code.

2. The proposed concerts will add vitality to the downtown core as deemed an important Town goal in the 2007 Master Plan and reiterated during community meetings hosted by the Town and in the recent DAAC Report for the Our Town Planning Area.

### CONCLUSIONS

Based on the evidence, testimony, exhibits, and comments from the public, Applicant and Town Staff, the Basalt Town Council hereby grants approval for the Basalt Summer Arts Beat Concert Series subject to the conditions contained herein and within **Exhibit A**.

## Exhibit A

1. The Applicant shall adhere to all material representations made in, or in connection with this application.
2. The Applicant shall comply with the requirements of the Basalt Police Department. No roads shall be closed and up to five (5) public parking spaces may be closed on Midland Spur for loading and unloading purposes. The spaces to be closed shall be at the north end of Midland Spur near the stage.
3. The Applicant shall be responsible for trash collection and removal.
4. The Applicant shall provide recycle bins for the collection of commingled materials (i.e. glass, plastic and metal) and a volunteer to monitor that the appropriate materials are being recycled. All recyclables shall be taken to the recycling center at the conclusion of the event by the Applicant. Recycle bins will be collocated with trash containers.
5. The Applicant or associated vendors shall not serve alcohol on the park unless a Special Event Liquor license is obtained.
6. If food is to be prepared on-site, the Applicant shall comply with the Eagle County Environmental Health Department's rules and regulations related to preparing and serving prepared foods and obtain approval from the Eagle County Environmental Health Department. The Applicant shall also provide vendors with a resource list identifying sources of eco-friendly event supplies.
7. If linens, cutlery, and dishes are used they shall be reusable. Any single-use, food-service products shall be compostable or recyclable.
8. The Applicant or the Applicant's vendors shall not dispense bottled water in the Town's park. The Applicant shall provide drinking water for participants from local sources using some sort of tank instead of individual bottles. The Applicant also shall not provide plastic or non-recyclable containers from which to drink the water provided.
9. Event staff and volunteers shall be trained to comply with Green Event Standards and Conditions. Compliance with the conditions contained herein constitutes compliance with the Town's Green Events Checklist.
10. Upon the request of the Town Manager, the Applicant shall conduct a post-event evaluation and de-briefing report and provide it to the Town. The event report would

include pertinent observations, notes, and data that may help reduce the environmental impacts of similar events to be held in the future.

11. Any printed materials advertising the event shall, at a minimum, be printed on 50% post-consumer recycled content paper.
12. Any tents that are over 400 square feet shall be required to have a building permit from the Town of Basalt Building Department.
13. The Applicant shall provide a fire extinguisher plan for review and approval by the Fire District prior to the first event.
14. The bathrooms in the Wylie Arts Center/Planning Department Annex will be open for use during the concerts.
15. The Applicant shall establish a point of contact for the Town related to overseeing the event.
16. Insubstantial changes to this approval may be authorized by the Town Manager.
