

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BASALT, COLORADO, RELATED TO AN
UPDATE OF THE TOWN'S ORGANIZATIONAL CHART**

RECITALS

1. The Town of Basalt is beginning to pursue the redevelopment of the Pan & Fork area as well as the implementation of the Town's River Master plan.
2. The Town in its current Five-Year Financial Forecast shows an imbalance that will likely require a reduction in staff and a reallocation of responsibilities.
3. To accomplish this reallocation of responsibilities and implementation of the Town's River Master plan the Town Manager is recommending a realignment of staff to better meet the task requirements demanded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Basalt Town Council of Basalt, Colorado, as follows:

1. That the Town Manager pursuant to Article VI, Section 6.1 of the Town of Basalt Charter, and according to Section 2-61.5 of the Town of Basalt's Municipal Code has the authority,

Except as limited by the Charter, exercise supervision and control over all executive and administrative departments, including the consolidation or abolishment of administrative departments, the creation or abolishment of positions within existing or new departments and the hiring and firing of all personnel. The Town Manager may change the title or responsibilities of any employee or with regard to any position of employment in the Town as long as the Town Manager assures that all of the duties and responsibilities that are outlined for that position below and throughout this Code are assigned to an employee of the Town. The Town Manager shall be responsible for ensuring that each employee of the Town is informed of his or her responsibilities under the Charter or this Code.

2. That the Town Manager in so performing the tasks outlined in Section 2-61.5 is presenting the current Organization Chart for ratification by the Town Council.
3. That the organization chart presented in Exhibit A will become the official Organization Chart for the Town of Basalt, Colorado.
