MINUTES

M/S BY SARAH SHAW AND AIMEE BEAZELY TO APPROVE MEETING MINUTES OF OCTOBER 26, 2022 AND NOVEMBER 30, 2022. MOTION PASSES 5-0.

INTERVIEW POTENTIAL POST APPLICANT: LIGIA BONILLA

Michelle Thibeault introduced the applicant, Ligia Bonilla, who is a long-time resident of the Basalt area and Roaring Fork Leadership (RFL) participant who recently brought a collaborative project between RFL and the Basalt Library to POST for review and participation. Ligia spoke to her interest in giving back to the Basalt community, her interest in providing useable outdoor spaces for the community and being a voice for the Latino community on the Board.

M/S AMIEE BEAZLEY AND SARAH SHAW MOTIONED TO RECOMMEND LIGIA BONILLA FOR APPOINTMENT TO POST. MOTION PASSES 5-0.

PROCESS DISCUSSION – CONFLUENCE PARK/TWO RIVERS ROAD SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PLAN

James Lindt presented background on the existing plan, created around 2016 as part of a Safe Routes to School project. James updated POST that P&Z had discussed the plan and recommended the existing plan be reintroduced and updated rather than starting a new plan. James clarified that no construction was considered for 2023 as to not complicate existing construction scheduled for the Midland Streetscape project. Consideration of temporary installations such as pavement painting and/or temporary planters or such could be implemented this year. James clarified that the street abutting the bridge is owned by the Town. Amiee, Jason and Sarah agreed that the existing plan is a good starting point and can be updated (rather than starting a new plan). Julie inquired about items related to the Streets' budget in comparison to the POST project and if different budgets would impact the efficiency of the project being built. Staff clarified that the project would be constructed as a whole regardless of which budgets would be contributing to the project. James noted next steps for the planning process included bringing the original plan designer back on board followed by discussions with the business owners to discuss merits and concerns regarding the existing draft of the plan.

SWINGING BRIDGE PLAN UPDATE

Michelle displayed the solar bollards identified by Public Works for the Swinging Bridge path. The solar bollards are approximately three and a half feet tall with downcast light. The solar is an important aspect for lighting the path as installation of electrical along the path is not feasible. Julie requested Staff investigate if there is sufficient sunlight to charge these bollards. Michelle stated she would triple check with Public Works. Jason gave kudos to Town Arborist, Chris Beiser for the updated plantings near Swinging Bridge recently completed. Jason noted the plantings are appropriate and reinvigorate the area and that continuation of that planting scheme along the rest of the trail will look great.

PROJECT UPDATES

Catherine Christoff presented an update on the bandshell and restroom/bus stop buildings at the River Park. Final details and pricing will be completed at the end of the week with contracts for construction of each structure being taken to Council for approval at the February 28th meeting. Action on the bus stop could start March 6 and action on the bandshell early April – start dates for both pending material deliveries. Paul asked if the height of the stage had been reconsidered. Catherine noted she had relayed his concern and the design team decided to keep the two-stair design to maintain visual access to the stage.

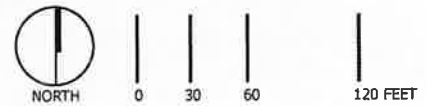
