Meeting was called to order at 6:03 pm.

1. Approval of Meeting Minutes.

M/S Karyn and Anna to approve the meeting minutes from February 2, 2022. Motion passed 3 to 0.

2. Work Program Items

Sara introduced the topic of the sculptures and suggested a focus on the location for the Basalt River Park, which has a planned area between the restaurant and the river. The theme of the park is “Eddy Out”, and the sculpture should speak to that theme (water, flow, swirl) in some way. Summers said that a call to artists is a great way to begin. BPAC may find an artist during that process that would also work to create the sculpture for the Willits Town Center area.

Karyn suggested advertising locally with Carbondale’s CCAH list of artists. She also subscribes to a national newsletter and will forward that information. Aspen Red Brick, ArtBase and Aspen Chapel are additional local resources.

Summers suggested dusting off the call to artists that was created in 2021 for the murals project.

Nancy Martindale, former BPAC member and sculptor, was suggested as a possible artist for the project.

To do: Sara will get images of the site planned for the sculpture at the Basalt River Park and get more information on the Connect One’s eddy out concept. Sara will also take photos of potential sculpture areas in West Basalt for consideration and add that to the next BPAC agenda packet.

3. Grant Program

BPAC needs to roll out this year's Grant Program. Sara asked if BPAC is interested in making any changes or adding criteria? Members suggested maintaining the same program as last year and updating the application.

Last year the grant was released in the spring and again in the fall. In the past funding has been awarded for Shakespeare in the Park and Pumpkin Jazz among other events.

To do: Sara will check the budget for the grants, and then get this advertised on the Town's website and in the newspapers.

4. Other

Karyn asked about the artist studio video project. These need to be uploaded to the BPAC webpage and Facebook page. Anna has volunteered to help with the webpage and Facebook page in Jeanette's absence.

Summers is interested in finishing up this project if it is possible. Karyn will check in with Charles about Barry (who previously had some issues related to the Town's insurance requirements that have been amended). Karyn will follow up at the next meeting.

BPAC had a discussion about focusing on the larger mural project later in the year. Members will bring potential locations to the group as they are found.

Staff will be asking BPAC to weigh in on language that differentiates murals from signs. Summers suggested working with Amy Kimberly for the murals and how to get the legal language settled around that.

To do: Sara will check into Carbondale's Code to see how they handle murals v. signs.

5. Discussion of Chair & New Members

There will be more discussion about the chair at the next meeting.

Summers will be away at the next meeting, so there will be a Hybrid option for joining the meeting.
