

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BASALT, COLORADO, APPROVING
MOTIO 2.0 INSTALLATIONS ON FIVE SITES AND PROCLAIMING JUNE 10, 2017
AS BASALT PUBLIC-ART DAY AS REQUESTED BY THE BASALT PUBLIC ARTS
COMMISSION (BPAC)**

RECITALS

1. The Council created the Basalt Public Arts Commission (BPAC) in 2015 as a formal advisory commission to the Town Council.
2. BPAC created "Confluence 3". Confluence 3 is a program comprised of three temporary sculptural installations, whereby each installation will be exhibited for two years, over the next six years. MOTIO 2.0 has been planned to be the first installation and BPAC asks that it be exhibited from June 2017 through May 2019.
3. The Council approved the contract with Demiurge in February of 2017 and issued the notice to proceed for Demiurge to repurpose and fabricate five pieces for installation in and around Basalt.
4. BPAC selected 5 sites for MOTIO. 2.0. One of the sites has two options. The Contractor is ready to start installing the pieces for completion in early June. Use of Town property for the temporary installations requires Council approval by Resolution pursuant to Town Policy 104.
5. BPAC is unveiling the art sculptures on June 10, 2017 and has requested that the Town Council proclaim June 10, 2017 as Basalt Public-Art Day.

READ AND ADOPTED on May 9, 2017, by a vote of 7 to 0.

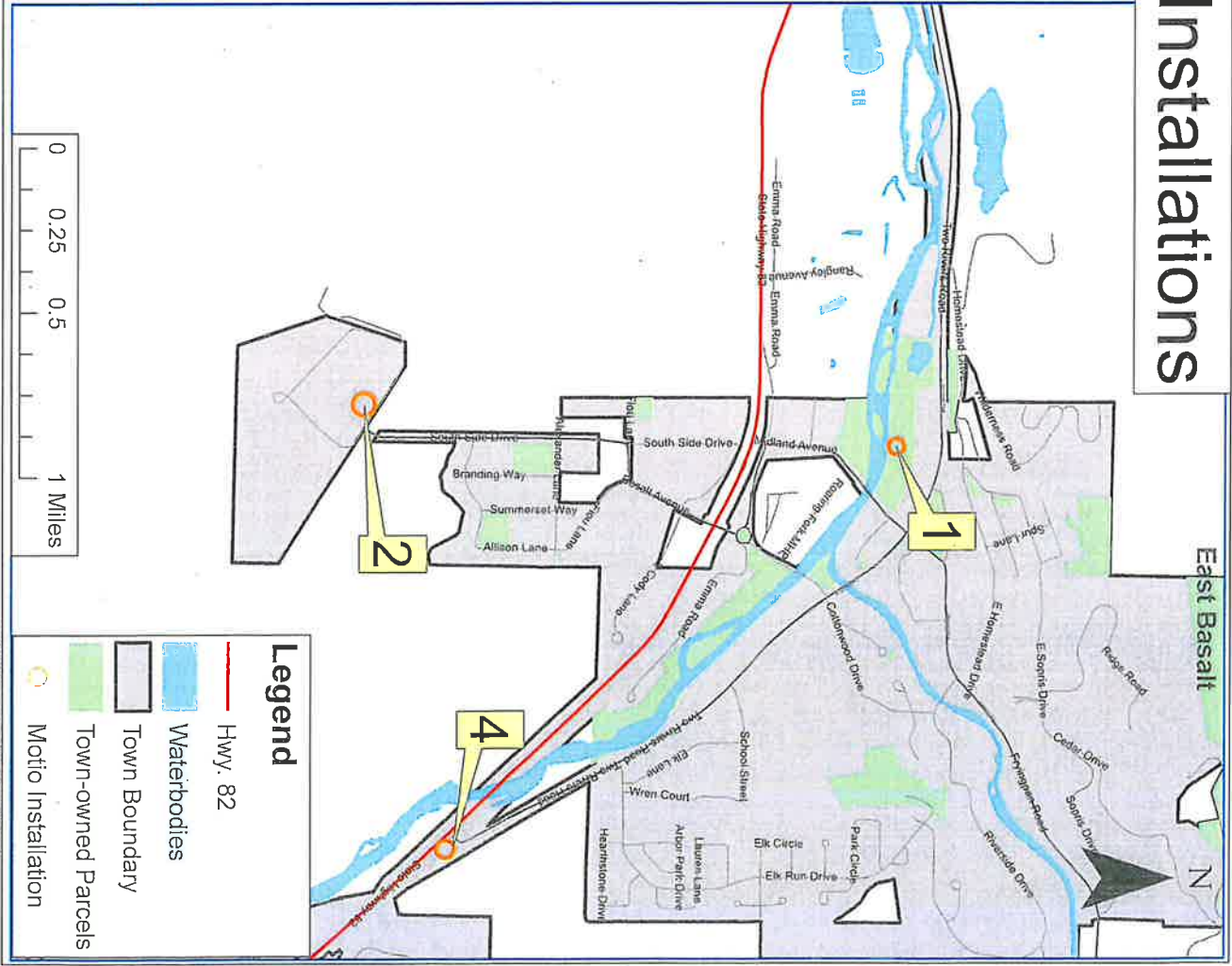
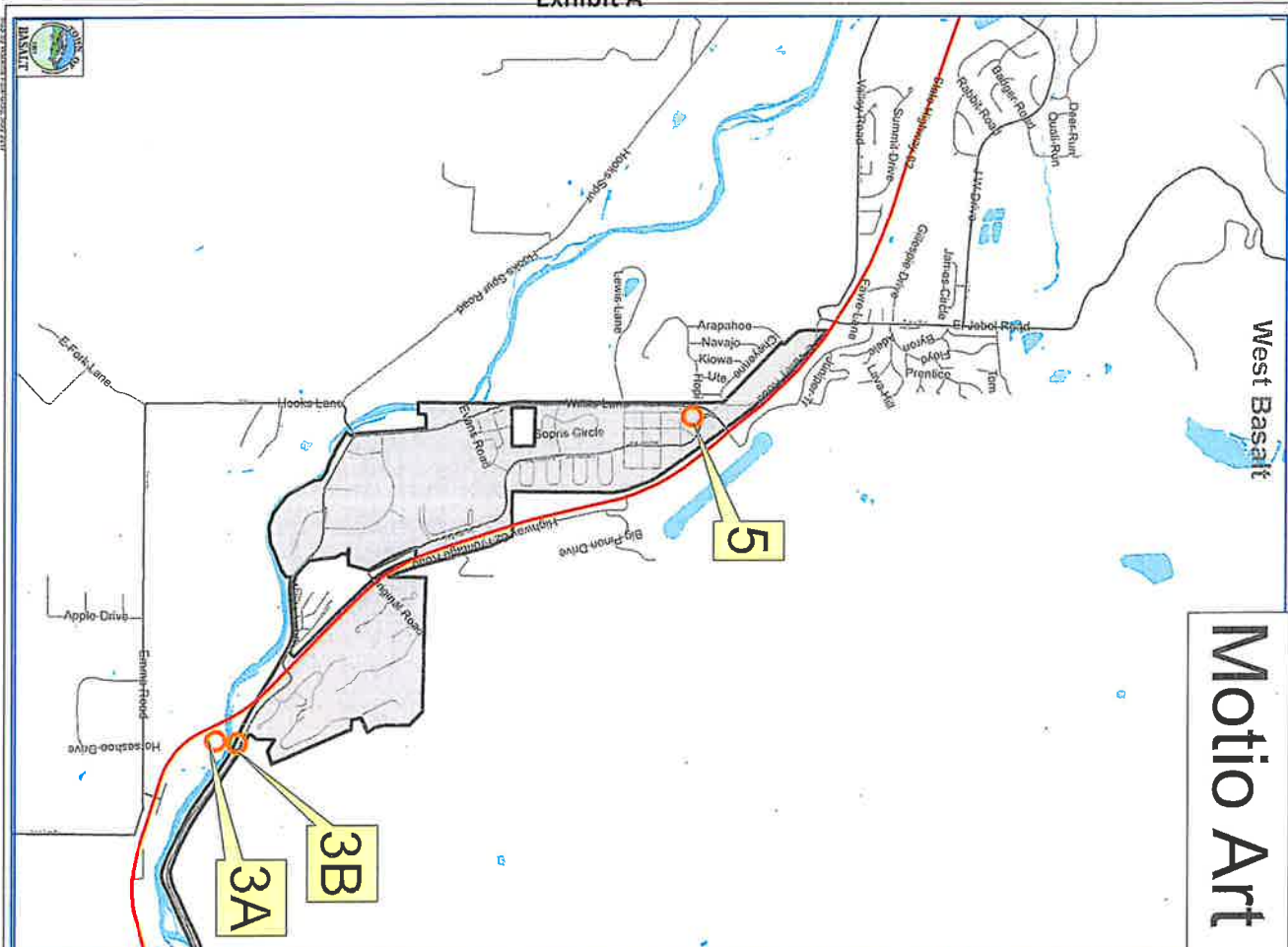
